What's involved?

Preparing for your training – At the training session you will try out delivering an activity taken from **the Futures in STEM Careers Resource** and take part in those prepared by other participants. So we ask you to come prepared to deliver a five minute activity. But don't worry it's fun to take part and we will send you instructions and all the information that you need after you register for the workshop.

Training Session - You will attend an interactive 3 hour training session, during which you will practice delivery of activities from the careers resource. Think about how to engage young people, learn about session planning and discuss the challenges involved in the role.
