They would like to know what you think.





There are 6 parts and 56 questions. It should take you about 45 minutes to fill in.




Is it important for them to recognise when people are having problems and need help? The questions are in the white boxes






You decide what you think and mark the scale with a cross

You can ask someone to help you write down your ideas.





