The University of Bolton's School of Health and Human Sciences supports the aim of the Skills for Health Bridging Programme, to provide opportunities for capable and motivated members of the Healthcare workforce to progress to health related HE vocational programmes offered by our institution.

The University of Bolton's School of Health and Human Sciences is prepared to consider applications from all candidates with the Bridging Programme combination:

- A Skills for Health approved Level 3 Vocational Qualification in healthcare (for example, a Level 3 Diploma in Clinical Healthcare Support)
- The Level 3 Certificate in Bridging Skills for Higher Education
- English and maths competence specified GCSE grade C or above or Level 2 equivalence

We confirm that applicants meeting these requirements are eligible to apply for the following programmes:

- Foundation Degree Health and Social care
- BSc Health and Social Care
- FDS Sc Nursing Associate

In addition to the Level 3 certificate in Bridging Skills for Health Education, we would expect learners to have achieved other level 3 qualifications (from September 2017 112 UCAS points) or equivalent and GCSE English and Maths at Graded A\* - C or equivalent to be eligible to apply for the following programme:


- BSc (Hons) Nursing (adult)
