

Custodial Healthcare National Occupational Standards Signposting document January 2017

Skills for Health and Justice recently conducted a review of the Custodial Healthcare suite of National Occupational Standards. The aim of this review was to ensure that the NOS reflect current practices in relation to the health and well-being of individuals in custody. The Custodial Healthcare NOS have been reviewed, updated, and rationalised. The final NOS now sit in the wider Custodial Care suite, resulting in one suite of NOS covering all relevant Custodial Care functions (including healthcare). Below is a table illustrating how the old NOS have been updated and any replacement NOS.
