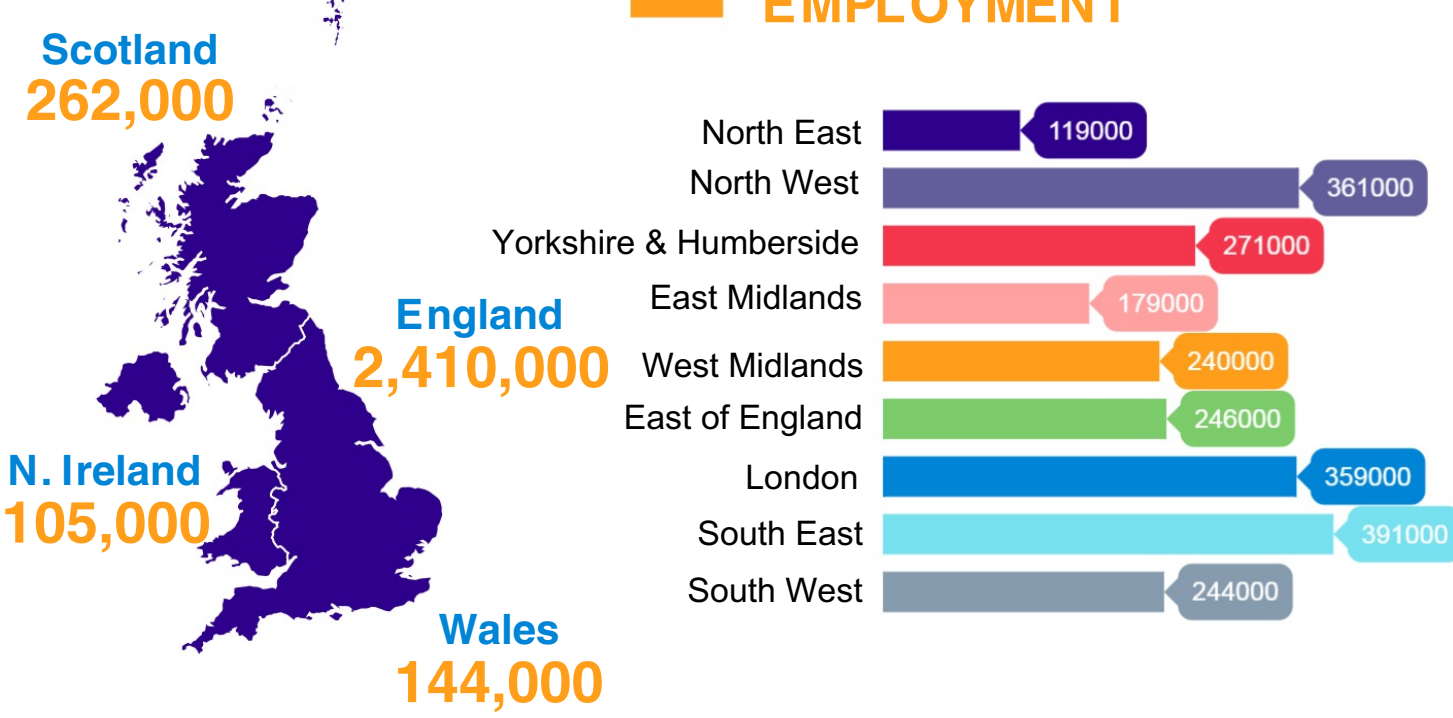

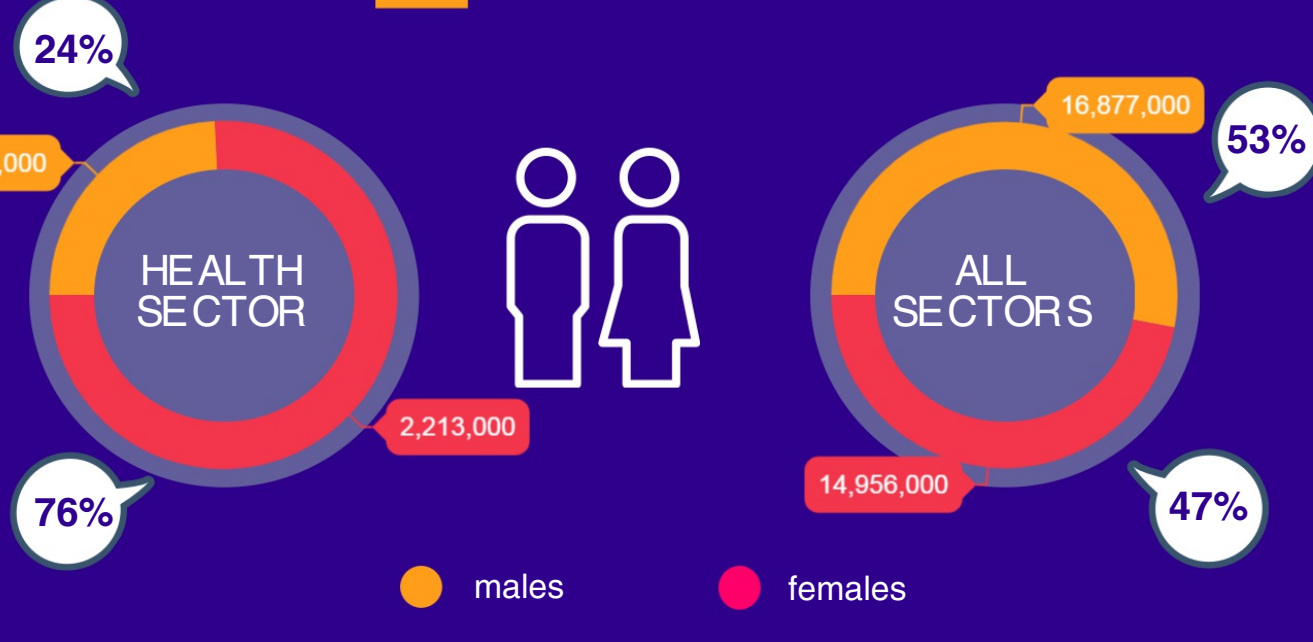

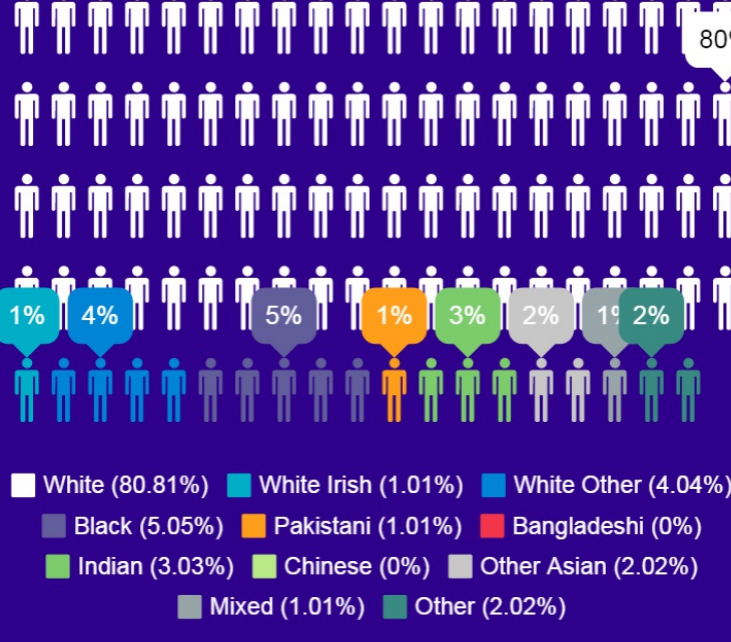

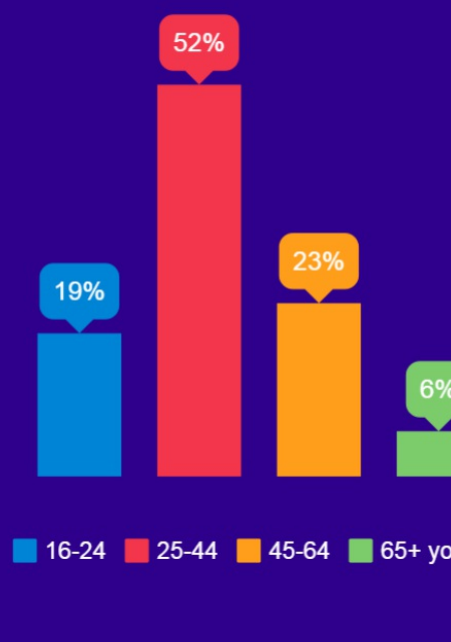

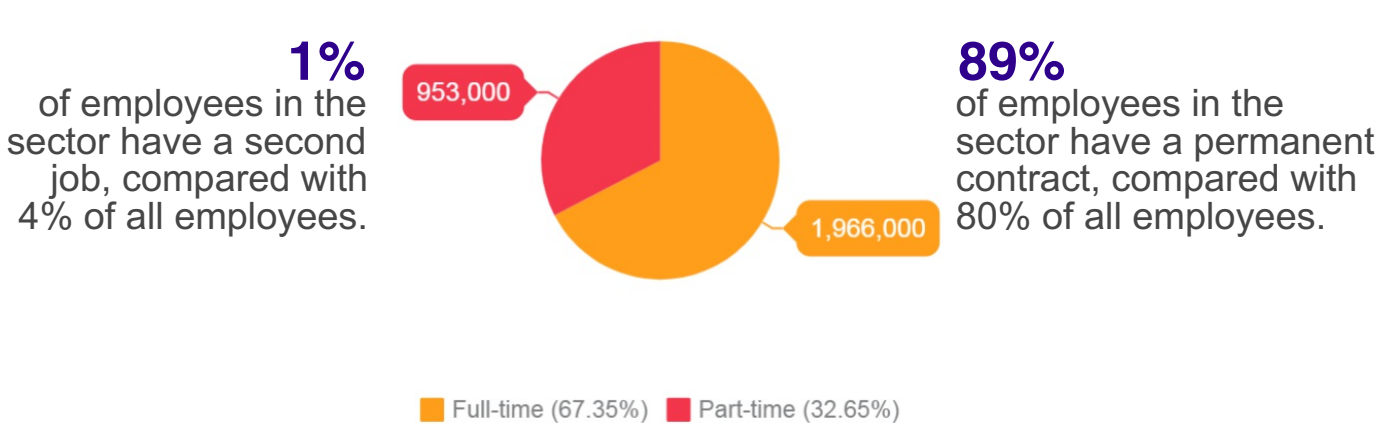

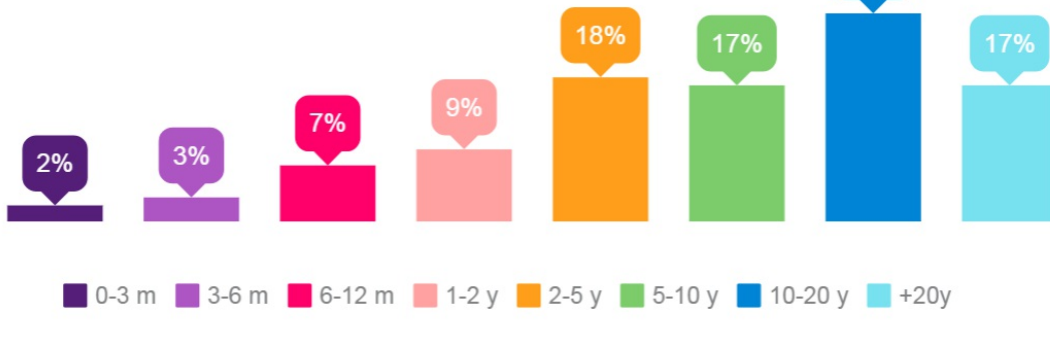

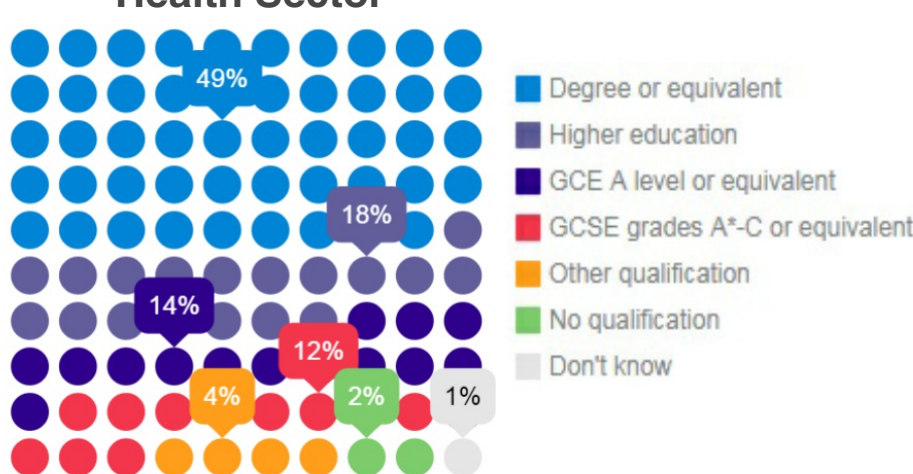

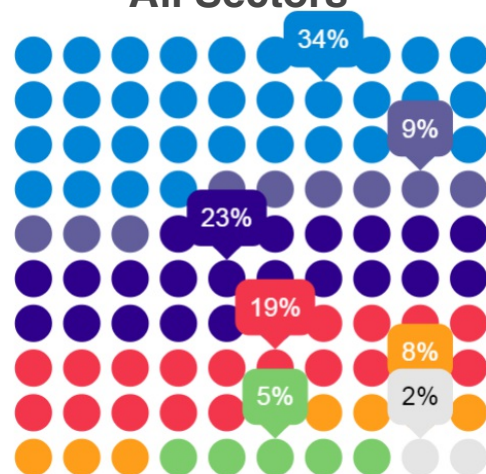

**24%** of the total workforce attended training in the last 3 months

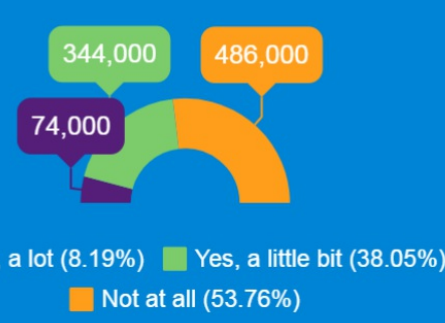
## 08 HEALTH & WELLBEING
