




This labour market bulletin for the Health Sector is based on data from the Labour Force Survey, unless otherwise stated. The data covers the period of April-June of 2017.


### 2,590,000 people employed in the health sector

#### **Full/Part Time**


1% of employees in the sector have a second job, compared with 4% of all employees.








