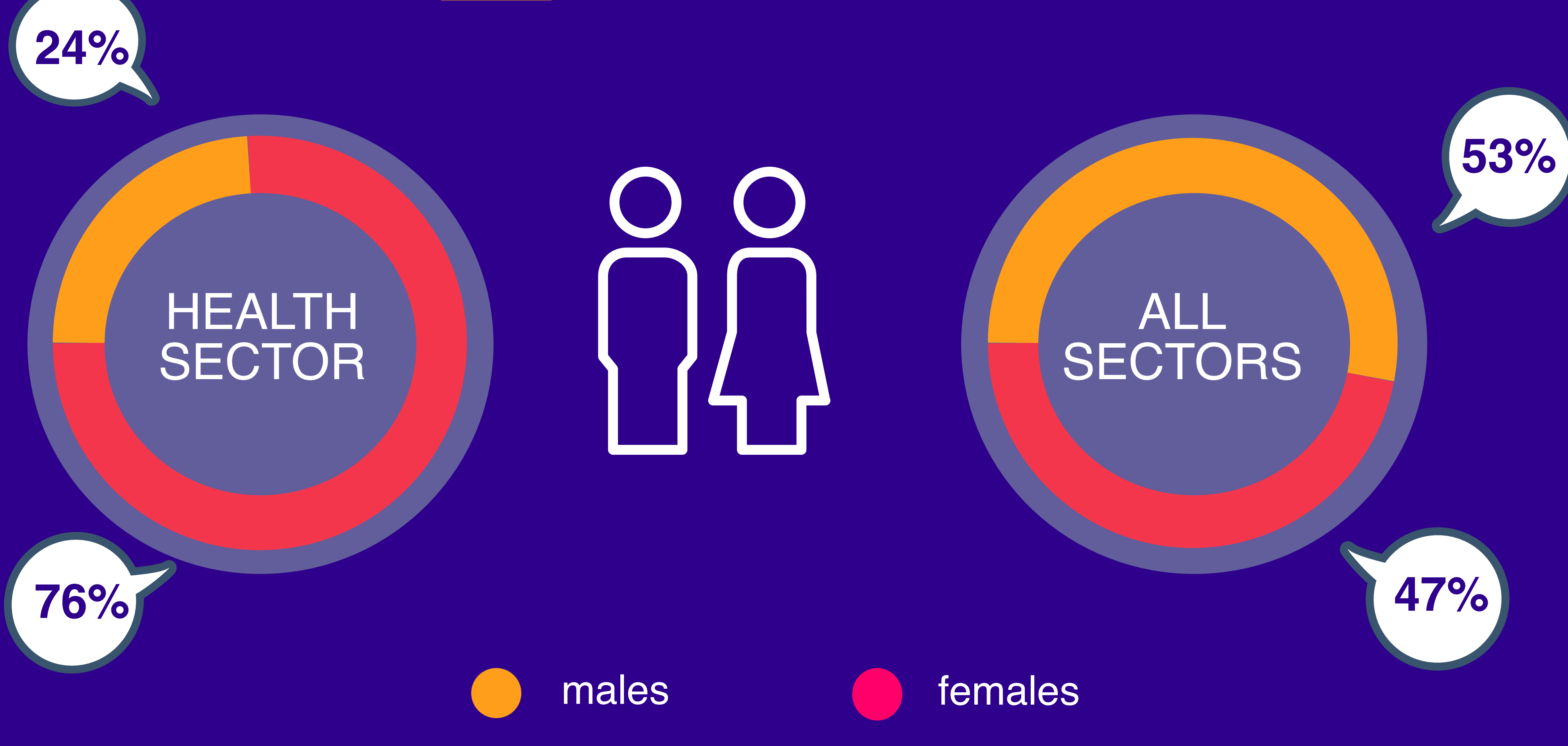

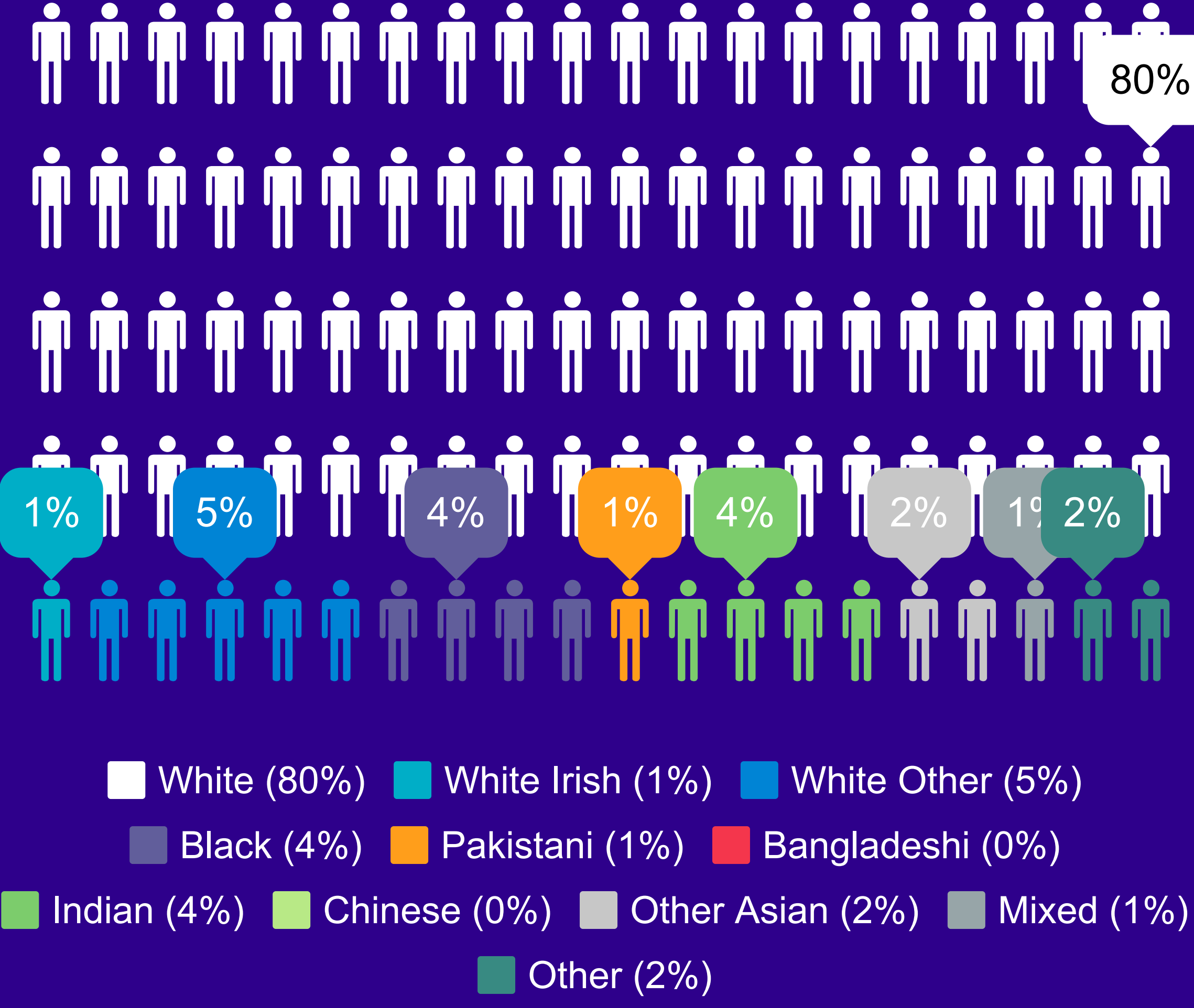

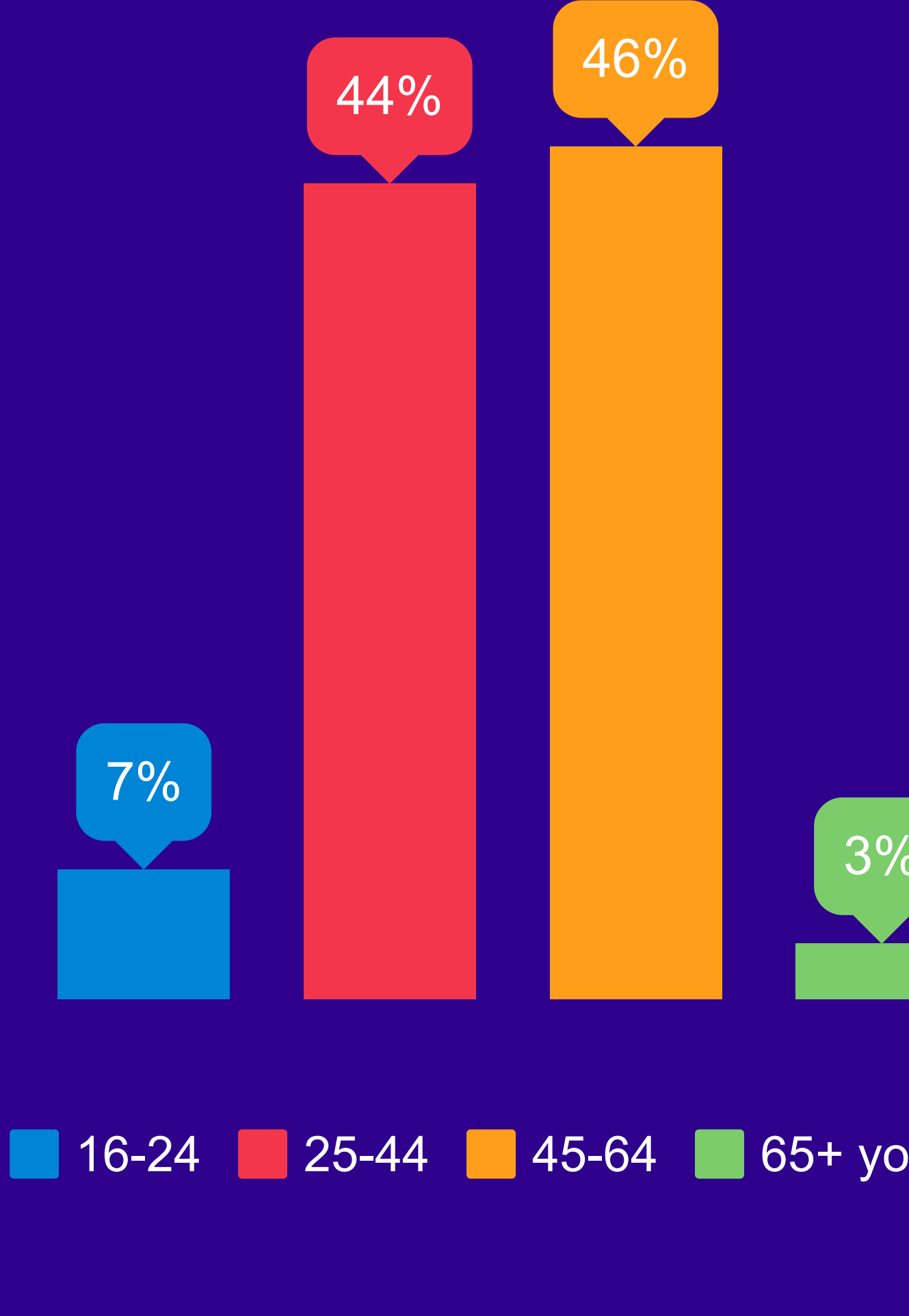

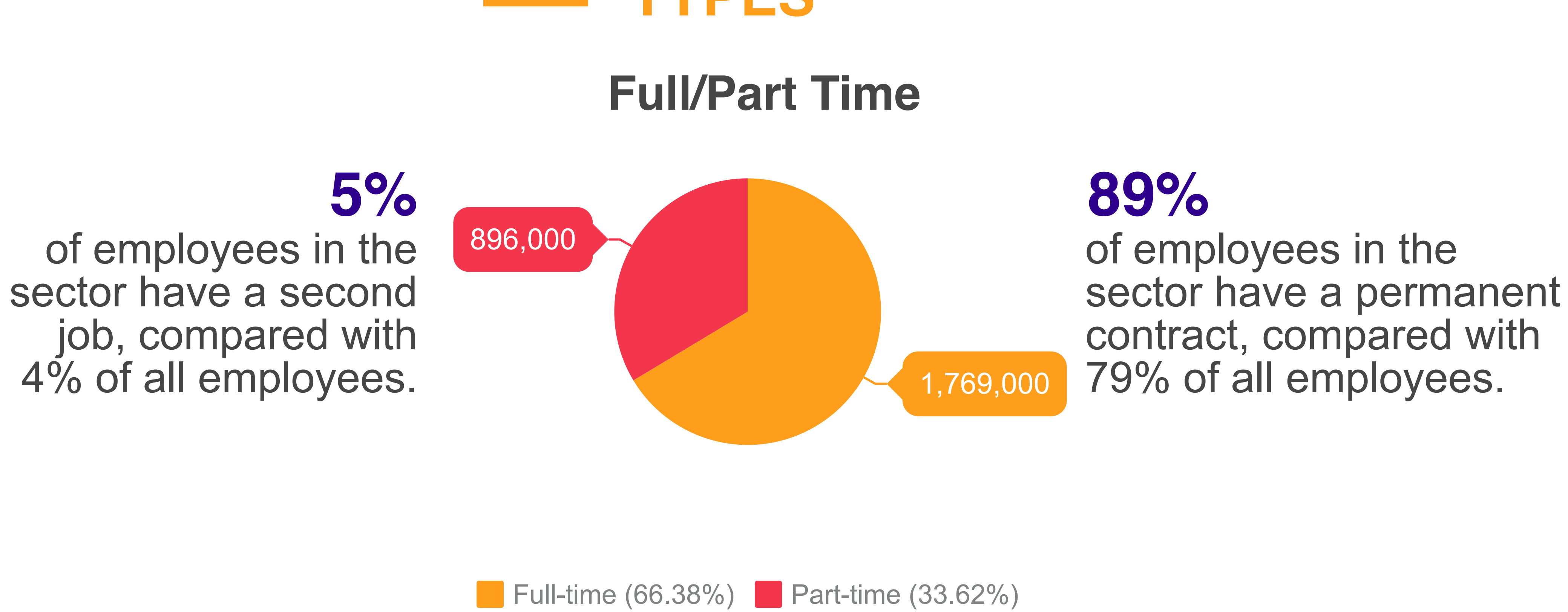

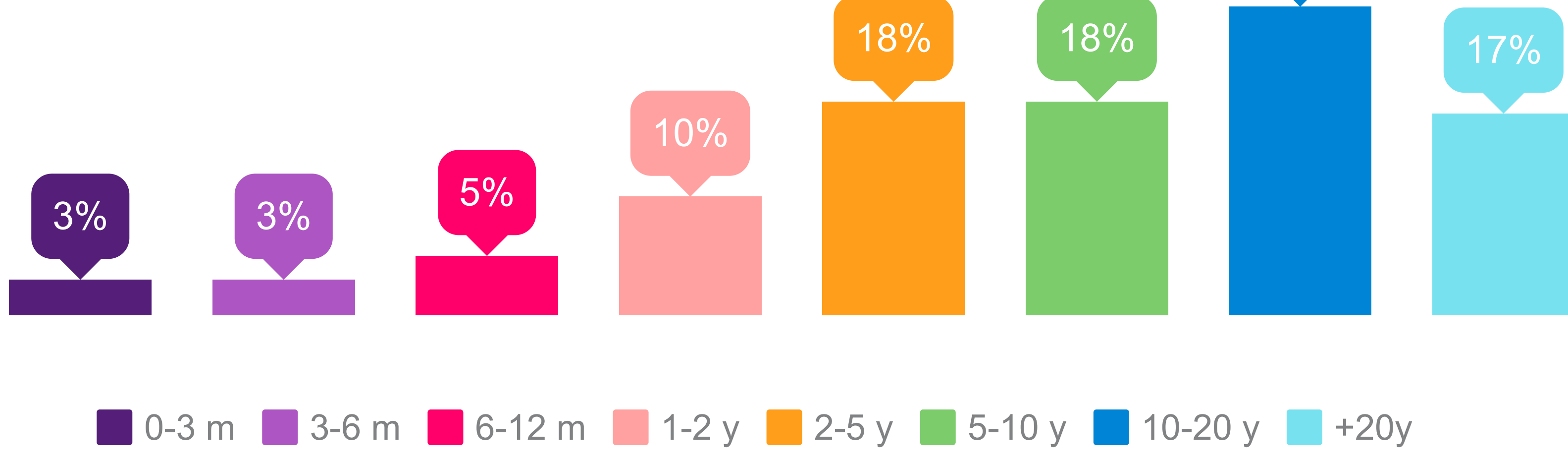

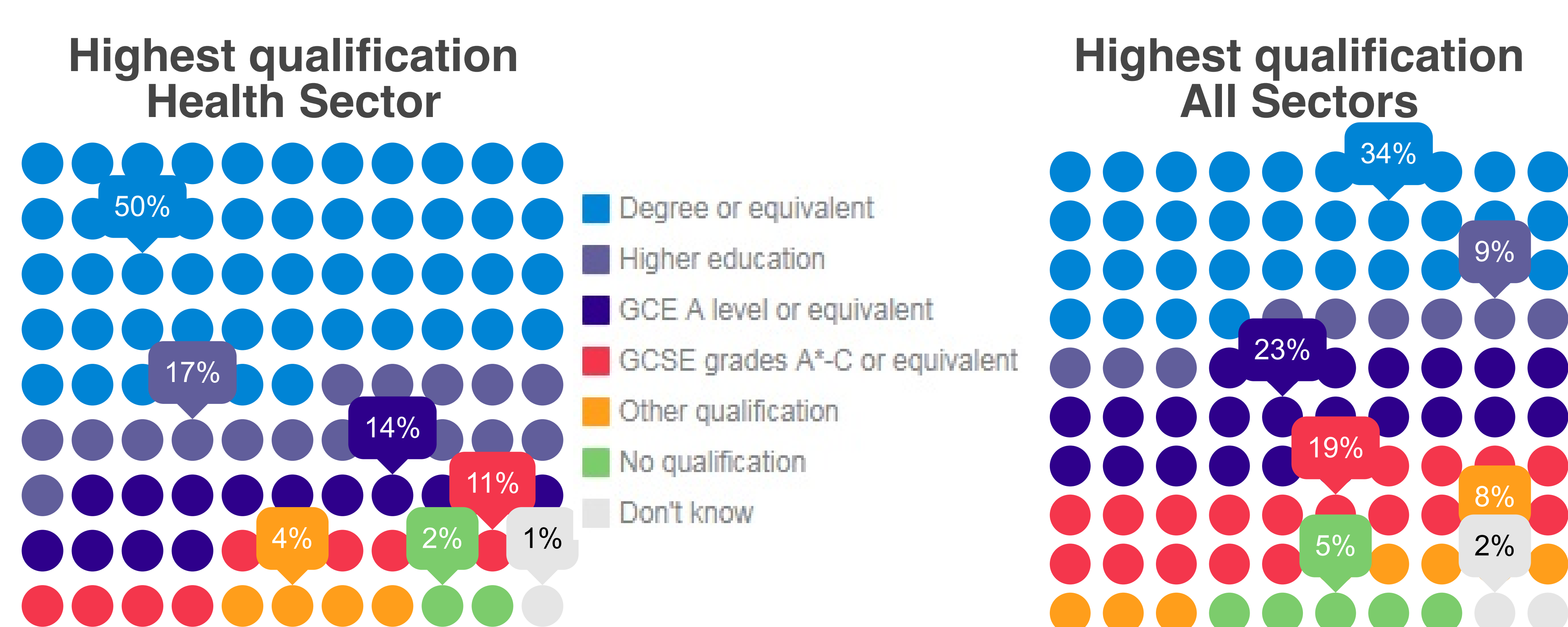

24% of the total workforce attended training in the last 3 months

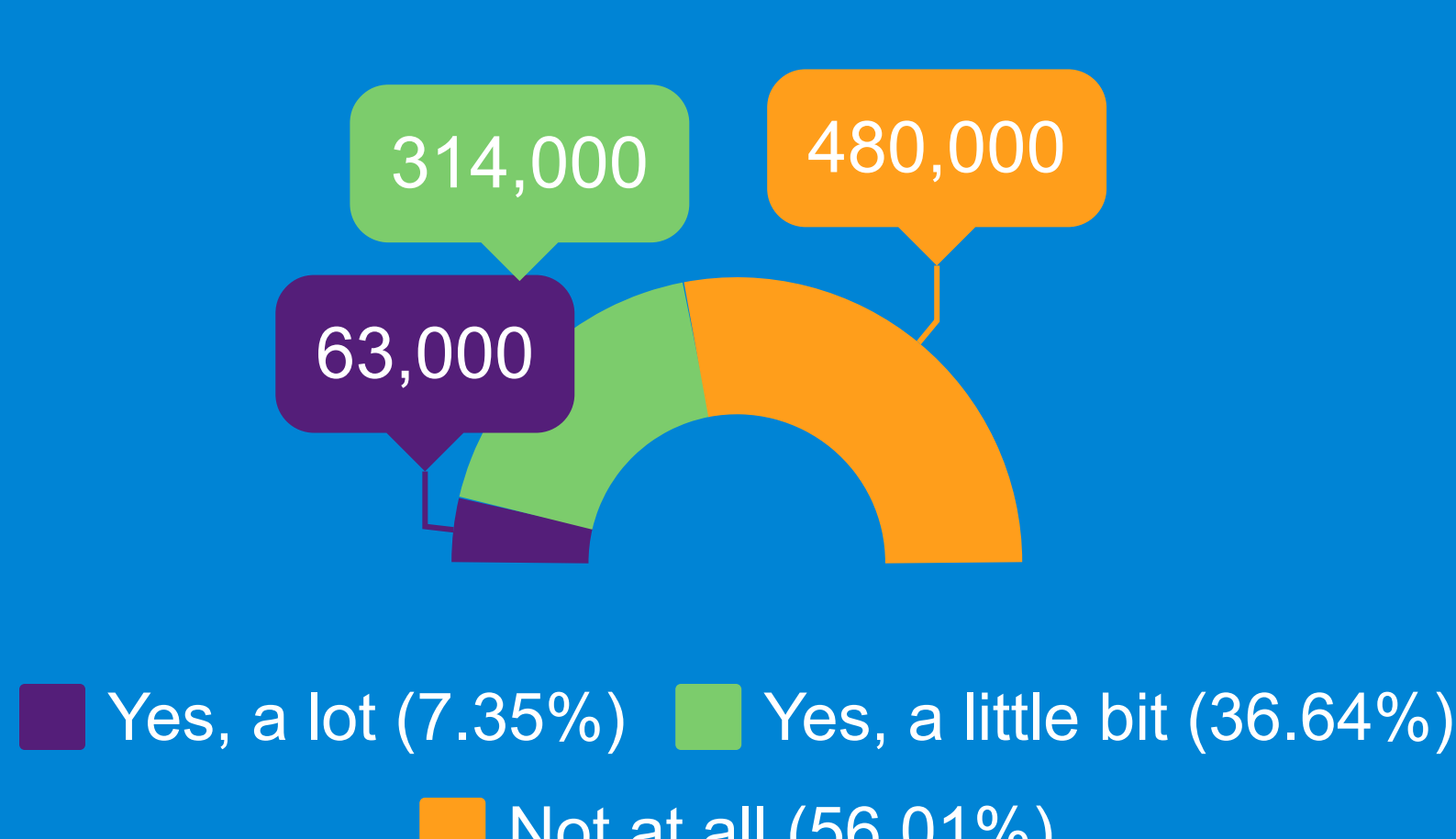
08 HEALTH & WELLBEING
