4.	Will read information you provide?

6.	Will understand medical and social care jargon?
7.	Is willing to care or able to cope?
8.	From a BAME community will not require services because of the extended family?
9.	Is involved in meetings with medical or social care staff?
10.	Will be able to support the cared for person to attend appointments?
