- 4. Will read information you provide?
- 5. Will have the relevant knowledge or skills to deal with a caring situation?
- 6. Will understand medical and social care jargon?
- 7. Is willing to care or able to cope?
- 8. From a Black and Ethnic Minority community will not require services because of their extended family?
- 9. Is involved in meetings with medical or social care staff?
- 10. Will be able to support the cared for person to attend appointments?
