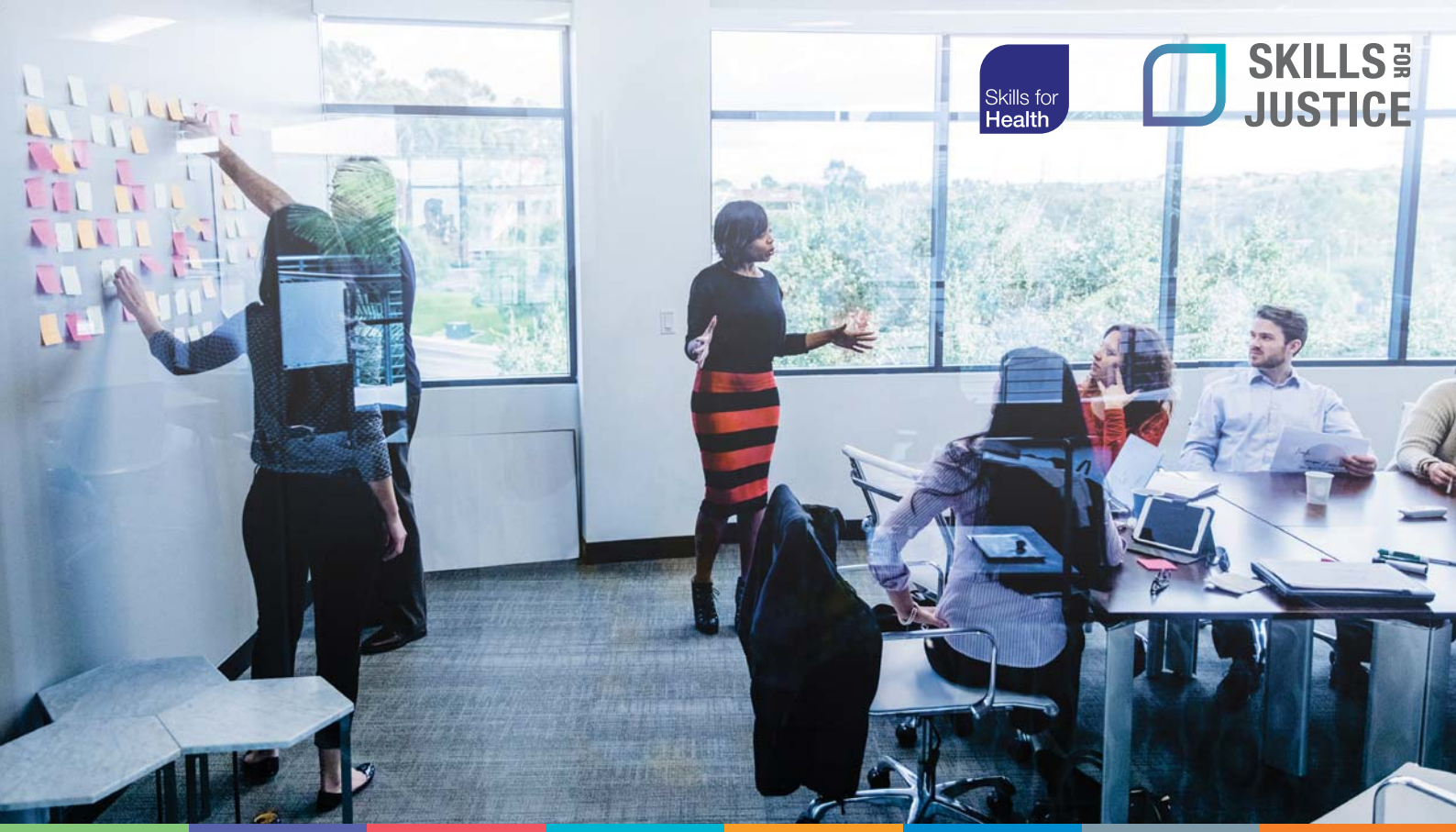
Our programme is designed for health and justice organisations who have a requirement to be on the RoATP, whether you're an employer or commercial provider.

New structures were announced in November 2018, meaning anyone developing an apprenticeship programme should consider key requirements before registering. That's where we can help.

Key RoATP changes

All providers must now be on RoATP – even those who are delivering less than £100,000 a year as a supporting provider (previously not required to register). Current providers will be expected to re-apply. The Education and Skills Funding Agency will issue invites in phases with the highest risk providers first.

There are no windows – providers apply whenever they are ready but are limited to two applications in a twelve month period. Main providers and employer providers must:

Be
financially
stable

Be ready to

Directly deliver
apprenticeship
training

Supporting providers must have been trading for three months, are limited to £100,000 of funding in the first year if they are new to apprenticeship delivery, and are subsequently limited to £500,000 of funding in any following years.

Providers with an outstanding or good grade from OFSTED are exempt from some application questions.
